RENEWAL OF MILLAGE TO PROVIDE FUNDING FOR ROAD MAINTENANCE AND IMPROVEMENTS TO EXISTING ROADS WITHIN ROCK RIVER TOWNSHIP

This proposal will renew the Rock River Township millage of 2018, permitting Rock River Township to levy 1 mill for the purpose of providing funds for the maintenance and repair of roads within the Township in the years 2024-2028 inclusive.

Shall the expired previous voted increase in the tax limitations imposed under Article IX, Sec. 6 of the Michigan Constitution in Rock River Township, of 1 mill (\$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value), reduced to .9700 mills (\$.97 per \$1,000 of taxable value) by the required millage rollbacks, be renewed at and increased up to the original voted 1 mill (\$1 per \$1,000 of taxable value) and levied for 5 years, 2024 through 2028 inclusive, for maintenance and improvement of existing roads within the township? This millage will raise an estimated \$48,323 in the first year the millage is levied.
